## Traditional Living Care

Our Traditional Living Care Plan is designed for residents who are primarily independent but may benefit from occasional cueing and reminders and who require little or no physical assistance with activities of daily living. An example would be a resident who needs reminders only with respect to one or more activities of daily living.

**TRADITIONAL LEVEL I PLAN** is designed for residents who are no longer fully independent, but whose care needs consist primarily of cueing and reminders and who require little or no physical assistance with activities of daily living but may require more frequent cueing and reminders. An example would be a resident who needs reminders with respect to one or more activities of daily living as well as with respect to mealtimes and activities.

**TRADITIONAL LEVEL II PLAN** is designed for residents whose care needs consist primarily of a moderate level of physical assistance with activities of daily living. An example would be a resident who needs some physical assistance with bathing, some aspects of grooming, dressing and continence management.

**TRADITIONAL LEVEL III PLAN** is designed for residents who require a substantial amount of physical assistance with some activities of daily living, due either to care needs or behaviors. Examples would be a resident requiring the assistance of two community associates for mobility and transfer, or a resident requiring substantial or total physical assistance for dining, bathing, and dressing as well as moderate assistance with mobility, continence and grooming.

**TRADITIONAL LEVEL IV PLAN** is designed for residents who have extensive needs, for example: a need for total care with one or several activities of daily living, or a substantial amount of physical assistance is warranted on a daily basis. Also, a resident using a mechanical or electric lift for transfers on an ongoing basis would be on Level IV, at a minimum.

**TRADITIONAL LEVEL V PLAN** is designed for residents who need total assistance with all aspects of care (including dining), as well as, usage of a mechanical or electrical lift for transfers on an ongoing basis.

## Personal Services

### MEDICATION MANAGEMENT LEVEL 1

Assistance with medications, up to two times per day.

### MEDICATION MANAGEMENT LEVEL 2

Assistance with medications and/or any administration of medications – using either method, no more than three times per day.

### MEDICATION MANAGEMENT LEVEL 3

Assistance with medications and/or administration of medications four or more times per day.

### CONTINENCE MANAGEMENT LEVEL 1

Provides the products required for residents with light to moderate bladder incontinence, 7 episodes per week; not more frequently at night. These residents typically wear protective underwear or a bladder pad. Products required for continence management, based on assessed need.

### CONTINENCE MANAGEMENT LEVEL 2

Provides the products required for residents who are incontinent with bladder and bowel and are frequently or always bladder incontinent at night. These residents typically require protective underwear during the day and a brief overnight, or a brief 24 hours a day. Products required for continence management, based on assessed need.
